

The following letter was sent out to all Club Conex dealers on August 1st, 2008

Dear Valued Customer,

A response has come back to our office from the USGA on 7/30/08 regarding the conformance of our new, FAZ-FIT interchangeable shaft adapters.

Unfortunately, the USGA has come to the conclusion that FAZ-FIT is a non-conforming product and can not be used during stipulated tournament rounds or for the purpose of posting USGA handicap scores.

They believe this is accurate because they claim that FAZ-FIT adapters can be used when they are finger tight and that the wrench is not necessary for assembly.

This is difficult to believe and I find that they have given a bit of favoritism to the the larger manufacturers.

I believe this is true because FAZ-FIT has been tested against several system which have been deemed conforming and each requires the aid of a special tool in order to eliminate face rotation and be truly playable.

That being said, I've argued my point about as strongly as I can and have gotten nowhere over the last several months despite making very strong arguments to the USGA.

The USGA has sited that in order for FAZ-FIT to be deemed conforming that the part must have some type of agent applied to the upper portion of the threads which makes it impossible to be assembled without the aid of the wrench.

The USGA also stated that once this material is applied to the threads that the part must withstand 20-30 assemblies without the material coming of the threads in order to be deemed conforming.

Despite the fact that most of you have used FAZ-FIT as a fitting and demo tool, many of you have asked about it's use as a interchangeable system for play.

I am happy to tell you that FAZ-FIT is going to remain on board as our flagship product for fitting and demo purposes, but we will also begin development of a similar product in an attempt to meet the USGA's demands for a playable adapter system which we hope to have ready for 2009.

That being said, I want you to know that I greatly appreciate your business and I welcome your feedback.
